MATERNAL AND INFANT HEALTH PROJECT IN THE NORTH WOLLO REGION (ETHIOPIA)

Goals:

1. To construct and equip a mother-child ward at the Woldiya General Hospital, including emergency obstetric and neonatal areas.
2. To construct and equip a temporary shelter for pregnant women in their last stages of pregnancy and living far from any medical facilities.
3. To train the hospital staff and the community on the new development.
4. To empower women and the community to recognize the risks associated with pregnancy and childbirth and the availability of emergency obstetric care.
5. To strengthen the methods of collecting morbidity and mortality data, giving more information on the impacts of the project.
